Cycling Savvy Course Description (*)

- Part 1: The truth and techniques of traffic cycling (3 hours): familiarizes students with bicycle-specific laws, traffic dynamics and problem-solving strategies. A guided discussion with video and animation. Conducted in a classroom. Available a la carte.
 - Part 2: Train your bike! (3 hours): a set of progressive drills designed to increase students' control and comfort handling their bikes in various situations. Conducted in a parking lot. Available a la carte.
 - Part 3: Tour of the City (3.5 hours): an experiential tour of your city's roads. The students travel as a group, stopping to survey and discuss each exercise location. Students ride through location individually and regroup at a nearby location. Prerequisites: Parts 1 and 2.
- * Students must be 18 years or older, 14-17 years old with a guardian.
