This ID Theft and Shredder Event is a great opportunity for people to come and dispose of documents containing account numbers or personal data.

You are encouraged to shred documents that include credit card numbers, Social Security numbers, medical information and bank account information.

Additionally, Deputy Sherriff Cirigliano from the Allegheny County Sheriff's Department will be onsite collecting unused medication for project DUMP (Disposal of Unused/Expired Medications Properly).

An industrial shredder will be onsite to securely shred any documents. Phonebooks, newspapers and bound books cannot be accepted. Please limit your shredding materials to three small boxes per car. You will be given back your boxes or bags for your disposal. This event is for individuals only, no businesses.
