Public Safety

Sewickley Police Chief Dave Mazza gave an update on the Osborne Elementary School afternoon dismissal traffic issue. He is going to continue to work with the school district to come up with a solution that meets the needs of the school and prevents traffic problems.

Public Services

The Osborne Tree will be lit with a combination of existing strings of lights and new lights purchased for 2024. Brian Brown will be responsible for handling the installation and maintenance of lights and the removal of the lights after the new year for a contracted fee of \$500.

Leaf collection will be considered for autumn, 2025.
