

**Glen Osborne Borough
Committee Meeting Minutes
April 7, 2026**

Meeting called to order by John Orndorff at 7:02 pm

Attendees: Jim Cohen, Anna Stewart, Gary Shermann, Bill Monski, Matt Doebler, John Orndorff, Josh Lambert, and Greg Curran. Jennifer Coyne joined (by telephone).

The group went into Executive Session for legal advice on issues affecting the Borough.

The Executive Session ended at 8:42 pm.

Anna left the meeting after the Executive Session. Josh and Gary left the meeting shortly into Jennifer's report.

Jennifer Coyne updated the group on the Quiet Zone and Safety Improvement effort regarding the River Road railroad crossing. She met with the railroad company, which was not receptive and cited a significant fee to initiate an analysis. The company expressed more interest when it became known that some Federal grants had reopened that could apply to the project, with cost sharing. Jennifer quickly summarized a search on project history in similar situations with a variety of strategies and found there was limited success. Next potential steps are to do a new study; update an old study (and possibly to include Haysville in either); contact QVCOG; and meet with the company again.

There was also a general query about the zoning requirements for putting in a pool at a residence.

There were no other reports.
